

Step-by-step plan for registering a foal

1. Log in to Equis

[Log in with your personal account.](#)

[If you do not have a membership yet, activate it first.](#)

2. Check the mare's details.

Check that your mare is correctly registered in the system.

If your mare is not registered with the BPS, [you can report the birth via their link.](#)

3. Checking mating

The stallion owner or owner of the stallion must have entered the mating in Equis.

Please check that the following information is correct:

- The right stallion
- The correct date of coverage

If the coverage is not in the BPS system, [you can report the birth via this link.](#)

4. Register the birth of the foal

Register the foal in Equis within 30 days of birth. Fill in all details completely, including:

- name of the foal
- Date of birth
- Gender
- preliminary color

5. Chipping, description and DNA sampling

After about six weeks, you will have the following things arranged:

- Have the foal chipped (mandatory before the age of six months)
- have a description drawn up with the AES sketch form
- Have DNA taken in the form of hairs with roots

Required for this step

- correctly completed [AES sketch form](#)
- DNA material from the foal (hairs with roots)
- [DNA statement from the veterinarian](#)

The necessary forms can be found on the BPS website under Documents and then Registration Documents.

Send to the office:

Send the following documents and materials to the office:

- the completed AES sketch form
- the hairs for the DNA test
- the veterinarian's statement of the DNA collection



Important

- The name of the foal must comply with the rules of the studbook.
- Microchipping must take place before the age of six months at the latest.
- All data and documents must be submitted completely and correctly.
- Incomplete submissions will not be considered.
